2011 Nevada Legislative Update

Mr. Garrett Gordon

Mr. Gordon will give an overview of this year's Nevada State Budget, discussing the outcome at the end of the legislative session and its impact. He will provide a review of land use, zoning, and development related legislation that changed in the 2011 session. The discussion will include an assessment of how those laws and policies affect the State.

Mr. Gordon is an associate for the firm Lewis and Roca LLP. He earned a B.S. in Urban Planning from the University of Utah and a J.D. from George Washington Law School.
